SUBJECT: Update #24-2, Target Areas & Maps

The qualified census tracts ("target areas") applicable to the NIFA homeownership program are developed by HUD, for publication by the Internal Revenue Service (IRS). An updated list of target areas (based on 2020 census data) has been published by the IRS.

## Lenders must use the 2020 maps for all loan reservations on and after April 1, 2024.

The new target area census tracts are set up in LOL. The first-time homebuyer requirement does not apply to the borrower when a home is in a target area. Additionally, higher income limits and purchase price limits apply in connection with the purchase of a home in a target area.
